- The MEP attempts to remain politically independent as an institution. Hence, political campaigns should not be part of your preparation.
- Bear in mind that, if you want to make arguments or claims, you need proof and evidence.
   While researching you should not forget that some sources are more credible than others.

I would like to ask all of you to send me a summary of the research you have made, including two ways to solve the Committee Issue (about 350 words) by Friday, January 15<sup>th</sup>. I strongly advise you to take preparation seriously. Also, if you have any further questions about the MEP or preparation, feel free to contact me or the other members of the committee chairing team.
